Description	IN AND BEYOND CONTEXT This course critically examines and surveys a variety of Asian theologians in light of recent discussions on contextualization. Asian theologies are presented less as a subject of study per se than as an interpretive tool that enables students to find questions relevant to all who engage in the theological discipline across time and place. Evaluation will be based on informed and creative classroom discussion, presentation and a final paper. The instructor is a visiting professor from International Christian University, Tokyo, who will be the Singh Lecturer in Comparative Religious Thought and Culture at the GTU for Spring 2010.
